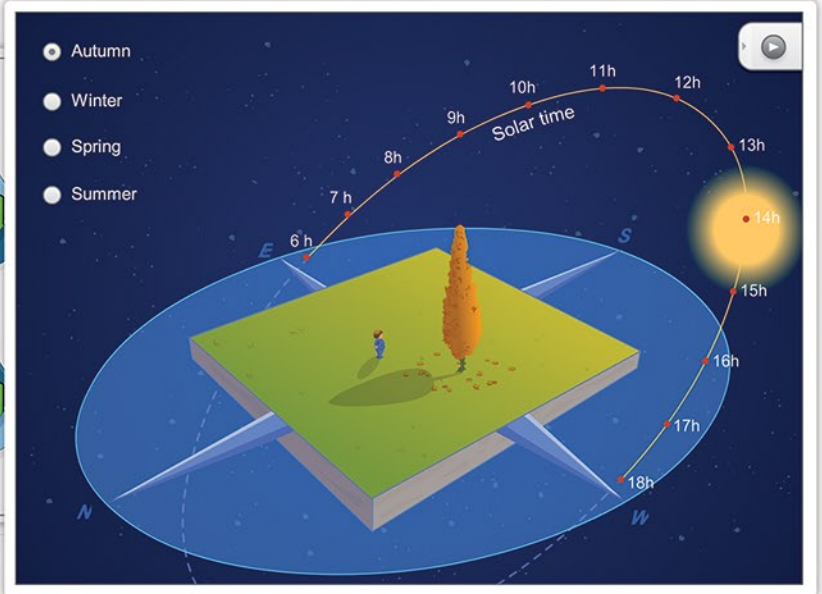

Summary
